Primary ELT Methods I: Developing Oracy Skills

Student's Work in using e-learning tools and emerging technology  
to develop primary school students' listening and speaking skills

Summary:

The lesson plans are designed by a ENG2256 student participant. They demonstrate the participant's ability in using different e-learning tools and emerging technology to develop primary school students' listening and speaking skills, including assessing their learning outcomes. For example, in the while-listening stage, students complete a video quiz in Edpuzzle to enhance the understanding of the words and the teacher can assess the learning outcomes.

The lesson plans aim to achieve several key objectives in primary English Language Education. Firstly, they seek to ensure that pre-service teachers demonstrate a clear understanding of learning goals and the latest curriculum guides, along with the competence to meet these objectives effectively. Secondly, pre-service teachers are expected to exhibit mastery of subject knowledge and language proficiency, employing suitable pedagogies that foster whole-person education. Lastly, the plan emphasizes the importance of catering to students with special educational needs (SEN) by utilizing e-learning tools, recognizing individual differences in learning, and applying appropriate strategies to address diverse educational requirements.

## Unit Outline

In this unit, the topic is “People at work”. Students will learn 10 different job names (Key words: teacher, policeman, firefighter, doctor, chef, nurse, pilot, vet, artist and gardener) and related sentence patterns. (Hello, sir/madam. What do you do? I’m a(n) XXX; Where do you work? I work in XXX).

There will be 3 lessons in the unit, 2 lessons for listening and 1 lesson for speaking section. In the first listening class, students will learn 10 different job names and have the chance to practice the use of the words through “Matching Game” in the pre-listening stage. In the while-listening stage, they will complete a video quiz in Edpuzzle to enhance the understanding of the words and the teacher will assess the learning outcomes by reviewing students’ responses and referring to the rubrics.

In the second lesson, students will learn the sentence pattern “Hello, sir/madam. What do you do? I’m a(n) XXX.” Then, they will fill in the song lyrics while listening to practice the use of the words and sentence pattern. In the post-listening stage, students are asked to finish a listening quiz in Nearpod to consolidate their knowledge. The teacher will evaluate their learning outcomes by reviewing students’ responses and referring to the rubrics.

In the last speaking lesson, students will learn another targeted sentence pattern “Where do you work? I work in XXX.” in the pre-speaking stage. For while-speaking stage, students will engage in a game in Wordwall to practice the use of the sentence pattern. In the final stage, students are required to do a role-play with scripts with their deskmates and perform in front of the class. The teacher will evaluate their learning outcomes according to their performances and assessment rubrics.
